## WING KUEN WEE, PDHPE TEACHER AUSTRALIAN CHRISTIAN COLLEGE SOUTHLANDS WA

Wing Kuen is a Health & PE Teacher who has found that using film is an effective and complementary teaching method, to keep his students interested and engaged. Wing Kuen began using The BULLY Project Educators DVD & Toolkit in June 2014 with his Years 7/8 and 9/10 combined classes. They concentrated on bullying and cyberbullying for a whole semester in which Wing Kuen used clips from the BULLY for Younger Audiences DVD and weaved them into discussions and activities with the students. The staff work closely with the school psychologist and the chaplain to monitor student wellbeing and implement evidence-based interventions when required.

“Aside from understanding what bullying is, watching the film has helped my students to visualize it. It has helped my students to understand what constitutes bullying and that it is not to be tolerated. It has opened up discussions between students and teachers, and my students are now more likely to report an incident to an adult/teacher when that occurs either to themselves or when they are a bystander. The resource aids in educating and equipping our students with the necessary strategies to deal with what they might encounter be it as a victim or bystander and also as a community.”
