



IDEAS: HOW TO USE THE TOOLKIT

USING THE BULLY PROJECT TOOLKIT WITH PARENTS

Scenario: The teachers at *Same School* have watched BULLY followed by a discussion based on The BULLY Project's Teacher Further Learning resource. The school decides that to support the students in their school, they need to create greater awareness with parents around bullying, what to look out for and how to support their kids through a tough time.

Actions: *Same School* host a special P&C meeting to screen BULLY followed by a discussion. The discussion takes parents through 'what to look out for' and the 'tips to help your child' at bullyingnoway.gov.au/parents. Parents are also encouraged to go through the interactive resource at stopbullying.adcouncil.org/bully and taken through the steps on how to notify the school if they are concerned.

Outcome: In the following weeks there is an increase in the number of parents calling the school sharing their concerns. Parents are better engaged with the school and more aware of their child's experiences at school. Parents are also more connected with each other as they work to resolve conflicts together. This provides a great opportunity for the school to develop parent-student UPSTANDER activities to create a safer and more inclusive community.
